 - A. Audit Report

Mrs. Filyaw presented the audit report to the board, and stated that there were no major findings.

B. Tax Levy Estimate and Notice of Intent to Adopt a Tax Levy over 105%.

Mrs. Filyaw attached historical EAV increase data, as well as information about the possible levy recommendations. Included was information regarding a 5% and 10% increase. Mrs. Filyaw stated that last year, the districts EAV increased over 10%, as all homes in our district were reassessed. The finance committee is recommending a levy that removes the working cash levy and lowering the tort levy, with the goal being that the overall rate be less than \$4.00, which Mrs. Filyaw stated will occur if our EAV increases by at least 5%.

Motion by Tina Litteken_, seconded by _Dustin Biggs_ to approve the tax levy estimate and notice of intent to adopt a tax levy over 105%.

C. Tax Levy Hearing Date

D. Liability Insurance

Mrs. Filyaw stated that the districts liability insurance is with Illinois Counties Risk Management Trust (ICRMT) and is recommending that that doesn't change. The premium increased about 15% (\$141,218 to \$163,458.) The Insurance is due to the districts overall property value as well as loss ratio. Mrs. Filyaw added that in the last 5 years, the insurance has paid out \$109,983 and there is \$81,788 outstanding. She finished by stating that the districts property value has increased by 10%.

E. ISBE School Maintenance Grant

The School Maintenance Grant is due on Friday, December 13, and is a \$50,000 matching grant. Mrs. Filyaw stated that the Building and Grounds committee discussed this on Wednesday evening and have decided to submit a proposal for a door/door hardware replacement project. This will improve the overall safety and security of the districts facility.

Currently, the following doors need to be replaced:

- Trenton Elementary- approximately 6 set of doors
- New Baden Elementary- approximately 5 exterior sets of doors, and 1 interior door
- Middle School- approximately 3 sets of doors and new hardware on all other exterior doors.

Motion by _Dustin Biggs_ seconded by _Tina Litteken_ to approve the submission of the ISBE school maintenance grant for a door/door hardware replacement project.
