Building Specific Metrics Used to transition from In Person Learning To Remote Learning
November 2, 2020

Closure will be made per school and based on school specific data.

If 3 out of the 4 columns are highlighted in red, and will remain red for the entire following week, the school will be closed and transition to remote learning on the following Tuesday. (Monday will be a regular school day and supplies will be sent home.)

- The school will remain on remote learning for approximately 14 days. The exact length will be communicated once all factors are reviewed.
 - During the period of closure, we will have limited attendance at the school.
 - We will not be offering supervision of students.

Nothing in this guidance precludes us from closing a specific school or the entire district immediately should a situation occur midweek that causes a significant level of concern.
